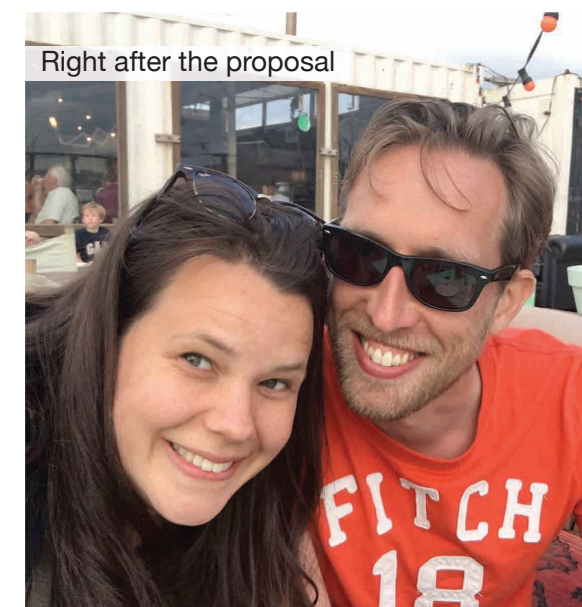

We like to be in our city and visit theaters, museums, and small festivals or just bike around. We also like being outdoors, taking boat trips or spending time with family and friends.

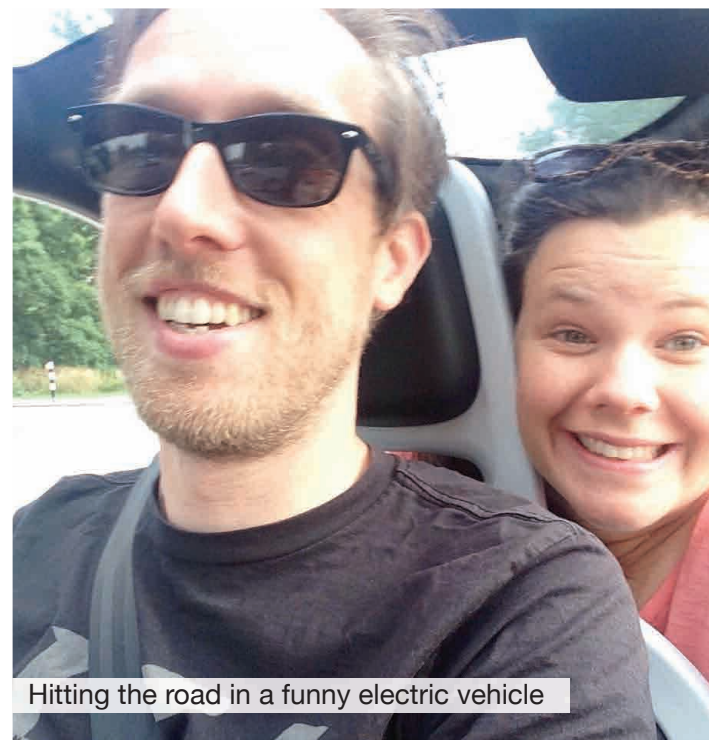

a museum or theme park, shopping in a special store, have dinner at a new restaurant or go to the movies.

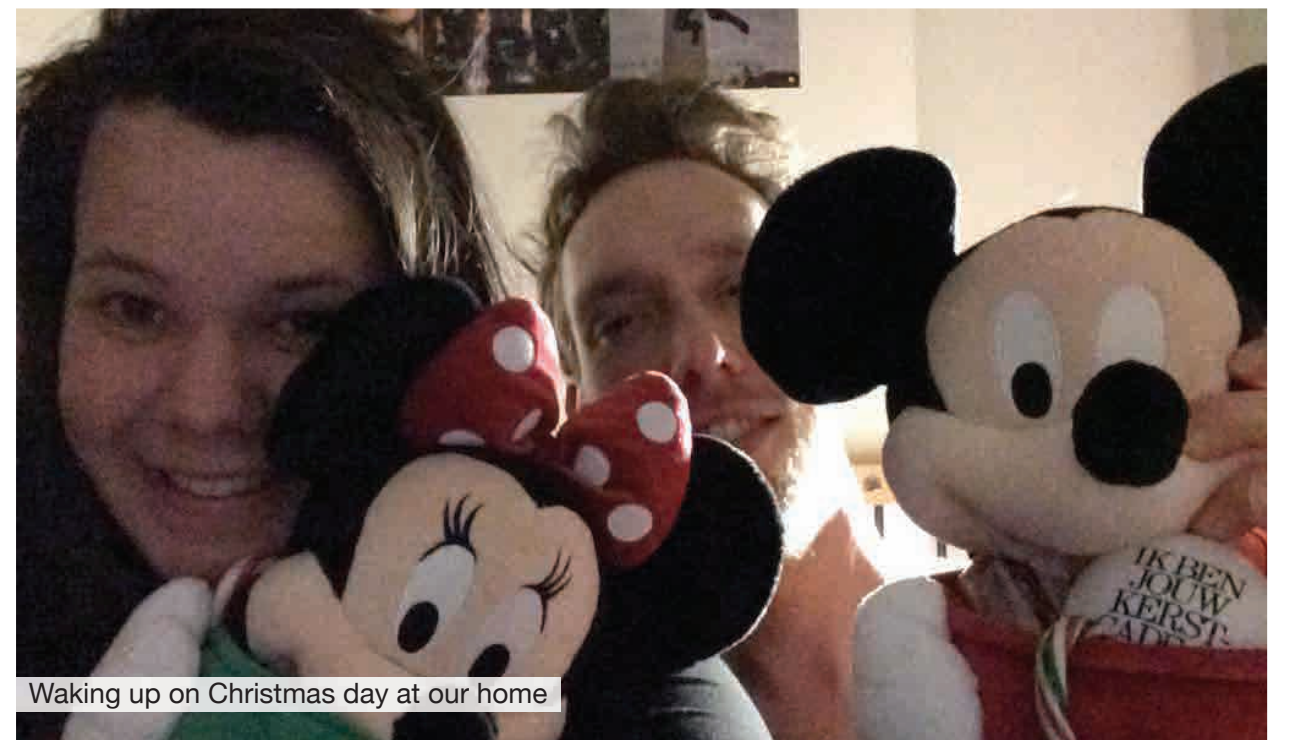

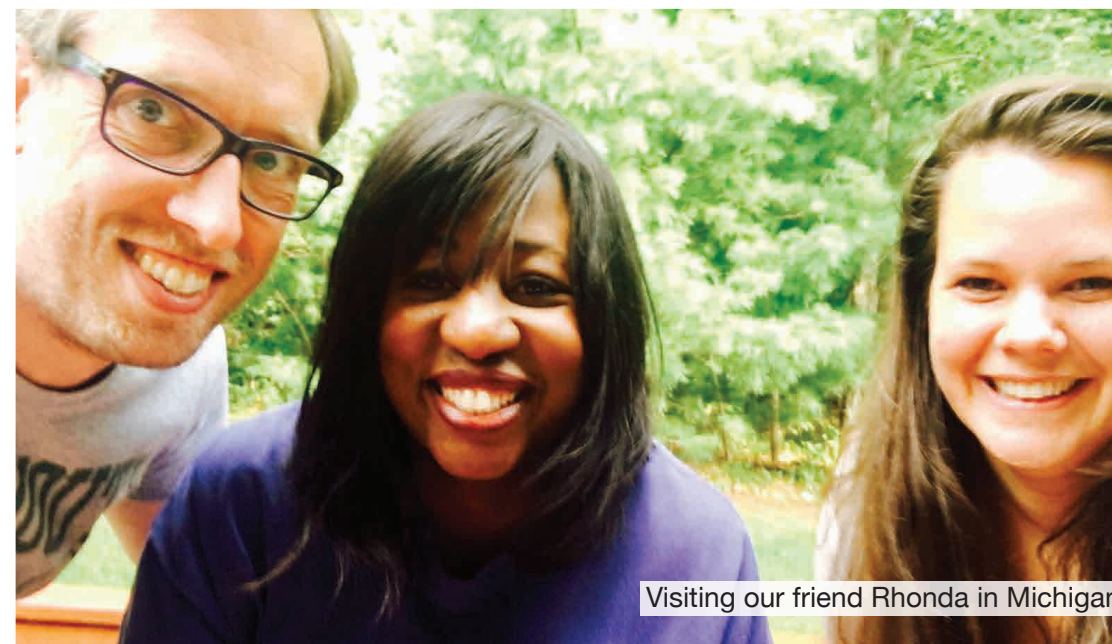

A lot of children of different ages and with different backgrounds live in our neighborhood. They like to play together every day and celebrate Halloween.

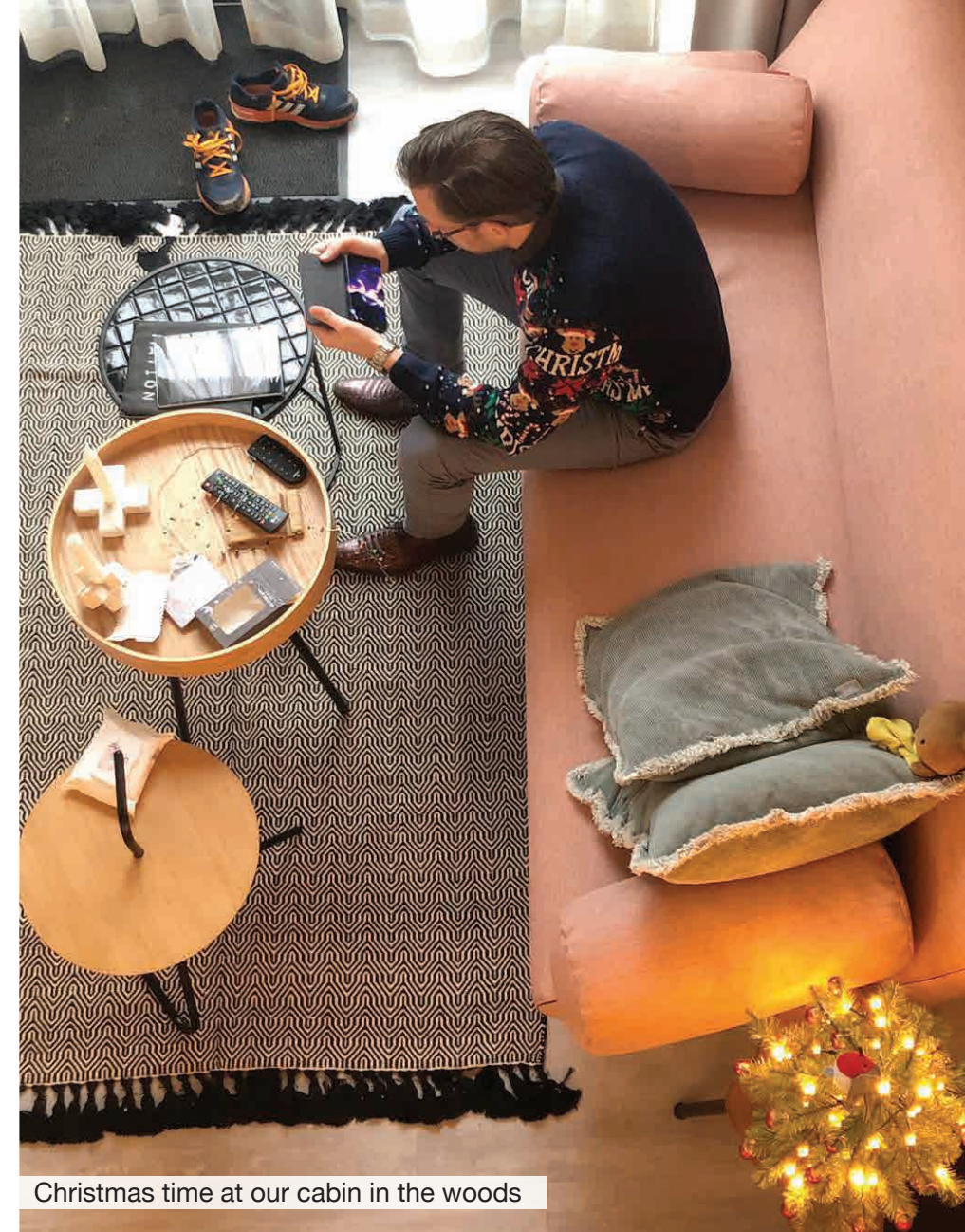

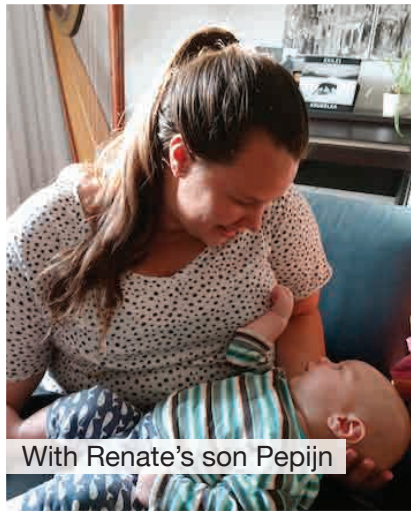
